Introduction

In music, the duration of sound and silence is important.

Duration refers to how long and how short tones and silence last. These tones and silence follow a certain beat. Beat can be felt with or without sound. We clap, walk, tap, march, dance, and play musical instruments to show the rhythm and beat of music.

Activity I

Sing "Leron, Leron Sinta" and move to the rhythm of the song.



Remember:

- The symbol (1) shows the pulse of the sound.
- Rest (*) is the symbol used to show silence.
- We can feel the pulse through clapping, tapping, walking, chanting, and playing rhythmic instruments.
